Venue/Rooms:

- All exams will be held in rooms 91, 92, 93, 94 and 95.
- Language speaking examinations will be held in rooms as advised by teachers. Teachers will arrange times with individual students to suit this timetable.

Examination Duration:

- All written examinations start with 5 minutes reading time and are 1-1.5 hours in length, unless otherwise indicated.

Student Instructions:

- Students are to **line up in alphabetical order in the Main Quad** before the start of each written examination.
- Students are to wear full school uniform to all examinations.
- Students are to arrive at least **15 minutes before** each examination is to begin. The starting times are indicated on the timetable. No allowance will be made for students who have misread the timetable.
- Students may enter the examination up to 30 minutes after the official starting time.
- Students may not leave the examination before the conclusion of the examination.
- Students may not leave the examination during an examination unless accompanied by a Supervisor.
- Any equipment brought into the examination room will be subject to inspection before the examination commences.

Absence from examinations:

- If you are absent from an examination due to illness/misadventure you must:
 1. Notify the school before 8:00 am and leave your name, examination subject and phone number with the Learning Office and
 2. Provide a medical certificate and/or written documentation to the Learning Office and fill in the online I/M form.
- Arrangements will be made, as soon as possible, for absent students to complete make up examinations within this examination period. Students results in these make up examinations may be used as a guide to estimate a final examination mark.
- Illness/misadventure provisions do not cover misreading timetables, misreading of examinations, equipment failure or any events which could have been avoided by the student.

Examination equipment:

- It is the responsibility of the student to supply equipment that is in good working order. This includes calculators.
