Orange

There is so much to see and do in Orange so have listed a few favourites. There is some seriously great wine, food and shopping.

Shopping:

There are some awesome shopping options in Orange and surrounds that could do some damage to the wallet. All these options are within a short walk to each, except for the last suggestion:

- The Sonic – houses both Jumbled and Iglou, with Nimrods café inside; great mix of homewares, clothing, artwork
- Hawkes General Store – an Orange icon: great mix of homewares and clothing, also sells coffee
- The White Place; great mix of homewares and clothing
- Danielle Louise; ladies clothing
- Belle Amoire – ladies clothing
- Angus Barratt; leather goods
- Anything grows - nursery
- Eclectic - furniture
- Mary and Tex - mix
- Lucknow Boot and Skin Barn (Lucknow) – uggies and so much more (on the way in to Orange from Sydney)
